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Open Enrollment School Bus Policies 2021-2022

Dear Parents,

We would like to welcome you and your children back to the 2021-2022 school year. Buses will go back to operating at full capacity. Hand sanitizer will be readily available, students in the same household will sit together, and daily cleaning will continue. We will continue to encourage students to wear masks while on the bus. All buses will be equipped with UV Purifier Air Sterilization System Filters. The Transportation Department will utilize every available resource to guarantee the safe delivery of our students, to and from school. This will enable them to have every opportunity to learn and become productive and successful members of our WISD family.

In order to make this school year a success please keep in mind the following rules and regulations.

- Buses will leave the department at 6:15 a.m. daily.
- Students will be picked up at the closest school to them or the nearest corner street.
- First load will be between 6:30 a.m. and 7:00 a.m.
- Second load will be between 7:00 a.m. and 7:40 a.m.
- Parents and students should be by the loading area and not inside the yard or house. **Please be punctual on a daily basis.**
- The bus will not honk; it will delay long enough to open the door and then depart.
- **If parents are not at designated area after attempting to drop off the student (3) times in a school year, parents will need to provide their own transportation for the remainder of the year.**
- Transportation will not be available outside of the established school quadrants.
- Students must follow the same rules as in the classroom:
 - Stay seated at all times (in assigned seat)
 - Stay quiet at all times
 - Keep hands and feet inside aisles and inside bus
 - Exit bus at the correct location only
 - NO eating on the bus
 - NO drinking on the bus
 - NO weapons or drugs on bus
 - NO destruction of district property (seats, back rests or windows)
 - NO foul language
 - NO throwing of objects
 - Obey the bus driver at all times
- Parents will be charged the following damages that may be caused by their child:
 - \$75.00 per torn or damaged seat belt
 - \$50.00 per window broken
 - \$30.00 per seat torn
 - \$20.00 per seat or side panel graffiti
- **Students may not ride bus until damage is paid or arrangements to pay have been made.**
- Students may not ride the bus without a bus card.
 - First & Second Referral: Warning from campus (or what campus feels necessary)
 - Third Referral: Three days suspension from riding bus
 - Fourth Referral: Five days suspension from riding bus
 - Fifth Referral: Three days school suspension given by principal
 - Sixth Referral: Loss of privileges for rest of semester or year
- It is a privilege to ride the bus. A privilege is not a right, it can be taken away.

We ask that parents and students cooperate with our staff to make this the best academic school year ever.
